

THINGS TO DO



Take college Placement tests if college bound

ACT and SAT tests are needed for college and scholarships. "Test optional" schools do not require an ACT or SAT for admittance. However, almost all scholarships require/recommend one!

Begin researching colleges or career options

Not everyone is college bound, and THAT IS OKAY, but you need to start thinking about career options anyways. Search for job shadowing/internship opportunities now!

Make college visits and narrow down some choices

You will begin the college application process in the summer/fall of next year. Visit colleges in the spring and summer of junior year to see if it's the right fit for you! Is it soo big or small? Does it have your major? etc.


Stay on track to graduate! Make the grades.






Types of Aid


