NMCEL Scholarship

The New Mexico Coalition of Educational Leaders will award three \$3,000 scholarships to New Mexico high school seniors who will be entering a college or university.

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION AND SELECTION CANDIDATES

1. Candidate must be a graduating senior from any public high school in the state of New Mexico.
2. Candidates must have a G.P.A. of 3.0 or better for consideration.
3. Preference will be given to those entering the field of education (Teacher, Counselor, Social Worker, School Business Official, etc.).
4. Interviews with each of the top five candidates will be conducted by the Selection Committee in May.

APPLICATION PROCESS: Submit the following completed documents:

1. The Scholarship Application Form (signed by High School Official and Principal)
2. Two letters of recommendation from teachers/and or school administrators.
3. A typed 300–400-word essay outlining the candidate's reasons for entering the field of education.
4. Official High School Transcript
5. Scanned Application Packet of documents if submitting electronically.

Scholarship Requirements:

3. Applicant must have applied to any college, university, or vocational school and have been accepted.
4. Applications must be typed; NO HAND-WRITTEN applications will be accepted.
5. Complete application, including at least TWO reference letters completed by a 4-H agent, FFA advisor, and/or an Academic Advisor.
6. Read and complete carefully – Only completed applications will be considered. A completed application consists of the application, essay, and at least TWO reference letters.
