Attendance

If you are sick or going to be gone please have your parent or guardian call the front office to excuse your absence; you have 24 hours to call in order for your absence to be excused. If you know you are going to miss school please get with their teachers beforehand to get homework so you don't fall behind.

5 unexcused tardies= 1 unexcused absence and every tardy after that counts as an unexcused absence

More than 15 minutes late= unexcused absence

Attendance points are back!!!

Zero to one day absent per nine weeks = Four points added to nine weeks final average.

- Two days absent per nine weeks = three points added to nine (9) weeks final grade average.**
- Three days absent per nine weeks = two points added to nine weeks final grade average.**

Transcripts

GPA

Overall GPA is the weighted cumulative score of all classes.

A Core weighted GPA is the score of Math, Science, English, and History. Grade point average (GPA) is a scoring average based on the letter grades made each semester.

Each letter grade is assigned a numerical value.

A=4 points, B=3 point, C=2 points, D=1 point, F=0 points

Transcript request will be through the online system Parchment.

Get out the YELLOW paper from your folder. If you need a copy of your unofficial transcript or need an official transcript sent please use Parchment this is how you will request a transcript. Once your

Parchment account is set up that is how you can request a transcript.

Please do not ask me to print you one that is what Parchment is for!!

Transcripts are updated after EVERY SEMESTER!!!


Credits

- **Students need 50 credits to graduate from Artesia High School. Each class a student is taking is worth one credit per semester. You should have 42 credits by the end of your junior year. If you are lacking credits the classes that are on your schedule are the classes you need to graduate. If you are in Night School please remember that these are classes needed to graduate!**
- **Transcripts are legal documents. Please make sure the information on your transcript is correct, especially your full legal name and birthday.**

In addition to completing the application, applicants must: provide proof of residency in a mobile/manufactured home with appropriate documentation; provide a reference from a teacher or counselor; submit a personal essay; and write a letter of appreciation.
